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



KEY TRENDS FOR PHARMACISTS DEMOGRAPHY IN 2020

On january 1st 2021, there were 73,830 pharmacists (-0.5% compared to last year). This number has decreased by 0.9% over the last ten years.

The average age of pharmacists has continued to rise very slowly over the past 10 years, from 46.2 years in 2010 to 46.8 years in 2020.

While only 10.5% of pharmacists were 60 years or older in 2010, they were 18.4% in 2020. The change in the retirement age can partly explain this development. However, the population is changing. The number of pharmacists under 35 years old is increasing, and this may help to offset the increase - due to longer careers - the number of pharmacists close to retirement.

The highest average ages concern pharmacists owners (50.1 years) and medical biologists (49.7 years). Pharmacists in sections B and D are the youngest (42 and 44.3 years respectively).

The population of pharmacists is mostly female (68%), especially in sections D and H (80% and 74% respectively).

TRENDS BY SECTION IN 2020:



Pharmacy owners (section A)

The number of registrations in section A continues to fall in 2020 (-1.3%), in relation with the reduction in the number of pharmacies in France as a result of the pharmacy network restructuring, for which there is a trend towards consolidation of pharmacies.



Pharmaceutical Industry (section B)

The number of pharmacists in the industry continues to grow (+2.4% compared to last year).



Pharmaceutical wholesale distribution (section C)

The number of establishments continues to decline (523 establishments in 2020, a decrease of 1.3%), as does the number of companies (225 companies in 2020 compared to 228 in 2019, so a decrease of 1.3%). As a result, the number of pharmacists also declines (-6.5% compared to 2019).



Employed Community Pharmacists and pharmacists practising other activities (section D)

After increasing in 2019 (+1.8% between 2018 and 2019), the number of pharmacists in section D remains stable in 2020 (-0.9%).



French Overseas pharmacists (section E)

The number of French overseas pharmacists continues to rise in 2020 (+1.6%, as in 2019).



Clinical biology pharmacists (section G)

The decline in the number of employees continues (-1.8% in 2020 compared to 2019). The number of sites increases (4,746 sites, i.e., an increase of +2.5%).



Hospital pharmacists (section H)

The workforce continues to increase (+2.1% in 2020), while the number of PIU (Pharmacies for Internal Use) decreases (-1.8%), both in the public (-1.4%) and private (-2.1%) sector.
